GENERAL ACTIVITIES

1. 2 team meetings, 1 supervisor meeting,
2. Computers navigational equipment is installed on boats 217 and 218, boat 216 installation ongoing
3. 3 day training on the ROV training was conducted.
4. Rewriting SOP's ongoing.
5. Rewriting Crewman SOP's ongoing
6. 89 Timesheets submitted for April containing 1025.22 logged hours.
7. From January 1 to May 4th 341 Timesheets submitted containing 2929.99 logged hours.

Details/Rescues

8. **Boone County**: Drowning Christopher McAlister Taylorsport is ongoing. Over 500 hours have been spent on searching for Christopher McAlister. This does not include the hours spent from Hebron, TRT team and other departments. Agencies that have been assisting in the search is Hebron Fire District, TRT team, Ky. Fish and Wildlife and the Coast Guard Aux. The search is covering over 20 miles of the river.
9. **Campbell County**: Call out by dispatch to respond to 2 individuals swimming in the river near the "Beer Cellar". Ordered to stand down.
10. **Campbell County**: Called out by dispatch at 23:00 to respond to a boat taking on water. Departed Villa Hills at 23:40 arrived on scene at MM 465.3 at 23:55. Located 22 foot open bow Cobalt with 4 persons onboard on left descending bank. Lt. Reinhart from the Coast Guard was present and assisting boaters. Operator said his outdrive hit something mid-stream and began to take on water. Inspected the boat and found the inboard engine compartment had about foot water in it. Began dewatering using our portable pump. Pulled boat off the bank and towed to River Towne Marina. Continue dewatering while in tow, monitoring the leakage. Secured at Villa Hills at 01:45
