BOONE COUNTY WATER RESCUE

Significant Activities:

Campbell County

- 1. Dayton: Cabin cruiser taking on water. Bellvue-Dayton 225 secured passengers at Manhattan Harbor. 219 upon arrival located vessel which sank shortly afterwards.
- 2. Ft. Thomas: boat with 4 adults with engine failure, towed to Rivertowne Marina.
- 3. Ft. Thomas: 18' runabout, 2 adults, engine with low oil pressure, towed to Rivertowne Marina.

Kenton County

- 1. Newport: report of a unknown subject jumping off the 11th street bridge. Side scan sonar and ROV with sonar used, nothing found.
- 2. Ludlow Bromley: several adults on a pontoon boat with a damaged lower unit, towed to Fredrick's landing.

Boone County

- 1. Anderson Ferry: report of a fisherman disappearing in the river. Witnesses stated a male subject was in the water on a sand bar casting a net, when the subject slipped under the water and was not seen again. Side scan sonar used for 2 days during the evening. Subject resurfaced approximately 30 hrs afterwards.
- 2. North Bend: capsized boat with several adults safely on shore. Good Sam towed boat and transported those involved back to their dock. 219 followed as a precaution.
- 3. Petersburg: 2 kayakers stranded near Greater Miami River. 219 transported kayakers back to their group.
- 4. East Bend: 21' Sting Ray, 4 adults, engine failure, towed to Big Bone Landing.

- 3. Training and PR event at Ft. Mitchell FD.
- 4. Training dive at the Creation Museum.

- 7. Station 2 building maintenance on going.
- 8. 218, 219, and 220 in service, minor repairs ongoing.
