Significant Activities:

Campbell County

- 1. A.J. Jolly Park: Dragon boat races - 2 boats capsized, first with 18 persons and second with 22 aboard. All persons safely recovered with no injuries reported.
- 2. A.J. Jolly Park: Speed boat races – during race heat, one boat went air born and flipped on its top. Operator was ejected and sustained injuries. Boat 215 recovered the operator and performed an initial patient assessment. Patient was transported to the dock where ambulance 1281 took over patient care.

Kenton County

- 1. Covington: Report of a subject jumping off 4<sup>th</sup> St. Bridge, side scan crew scanned the area until notified subject was in custody.
- 2. Covington: Report of a subject jumping from Roebling Suspension Bridge. Side scan crew worked 2 days, nothing located by sonar. Subject surfaced 46hrs later, recovered by boat 220 a third to midstream towards Ohio bank.

Boone County

- 1. Nothing to report.
